Site prep is underway for new animal shelter in Brown County

It's been a long time coming! Strategic plans were implemented in the last several years to ensure the humane society was in a position to kick off a capital campaign for a new building. In late 2018, the decision was made to take on the challenge to raise \$3.2 million. Now, less than two years later, loyal supporters have pledged to donate enough to meet the goal. Construction has started!

Given the current environment, a physical groundbreaking could not take place. It was disappointing to not share this milestone with our community in person, but board president, Sue Ann Werling made the best of it. She shared a virtual groundbreaking on our social media in March. Once the announcement was made, construction crews wasted no time and were on site working immediately.

Disruption to the operation of the current shelter will be minimal and animals will be able to remain in the current building until the new shelter is operational. Construction is projected to be completed in late Spring/early Summer 2021.



This new shelter is only possible because of the outpouring of support from over 700 individuals, businesses and foundations, both locally and nationally. The generosity of our supporters always surpasses expectations and this was no exception.
