Animals move to new shelter facility

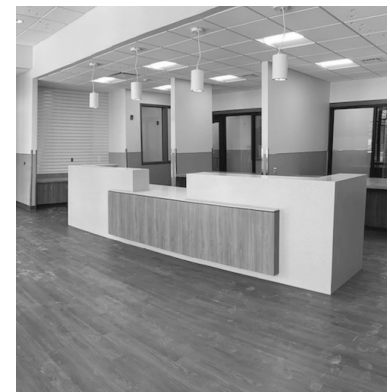
June 12, 2021 was an exciting day for the Brown County Humane Society. It was the day our dogs, cats and staff made the move from our 34-year-old shelter to our brand new facility. Just over a year after breaking ground, our shelter is now complete.

Our animals are now living in a place where their needs for comfort and health are met daily. Dogs are in kennels that are no longer facing each other and enjoying the view of our pond from their outdoor runs. Cats are enjoying a life of freedom in our community rooms. We could go on for pages about the improvements within the new building. It is amazing!

So many individuals, organizations and foundations came together to provide the funding for both the building and the needed equipment to furnish it. Recent grants include: the Smithville Foundation furnished the electronics for our Education Room and the Brown County Community Foundation provided funds for a new, professional grooming tub.

While we are thrilled to share this facility with our community, it will take us a few weeks to settle into our new routine. But, the exciting news is that plans for a public grand opening celebration are underway.

With the move comes changes to our operations. The shelter will now return to normal operating hours of being open to the public Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat and Sun from Noon to 5pm. While we will no longer require appointments, they are still strongly encouraged and will take priority over walk-ins. We are grateful to our community who helped provide a facility that allows us to open our doors to the public once again. We will see you soon!
